Helped our friend's brother who was in a motorcycle accident and ran out of insurance.










IMPACTING OUR LOCAL COMMUNITIES

UNIQUE HIRING

Aspiring to be a redemptive organization, we challenge ourselves to think differently about hiring. As we think about our mission statement's second line, Help People Develop, we want to create opportunities for those with barriers to entering the workforce. We've hired through CareerSpring, offering internships to students who are first generation college students, and often minorities. We've also hired through Open Door Mission, WorkFaith Connection, and Redeemed Ministries.

Partnering with Crosswalk Center since 2018, RTI's Houston Distribution Center staff is 80% ex-offenders. There are so many wins with our commitment to give 2nd chances to Crosswalk Center clients: reduced recidivism for Houston, flourishing careers, and an exceptional culture of safety and excellence for a critical part of our business.

George Floyd's tragic death triggered an intentional trip to HDC to check in with our team. Asking what RTI could do to advance racial reconciliation, our Crosswalk Center graduates asked for a chance to "give back". Several men shared a desire to intercept kids from making tragic decisions leading to incarceration. Through prayer and networking, RTI found an outlet for our Crosswalk Center Artisans to give back, sharing their personal stories with students in Alternative Learning Centers.

Twice a month during the school year, Artisans from our HDC travel to Richey Academy and meet with a tough audience -middle school and high school students! We love praying for Richey Academy students and sharing that drugs, guns, and gangs are not their only choices, and that purposeful work can bring a fulfilling future!

Southern Brush literally did the heavy lifting, clearing the lot across from the street. They heroically donated their time and resources to set up MLK Day for success.




CARE FOR OUR GLOBAL COMMUNITY

It's easy to watch the news and feel overwhelmed. Hunger, poverty, war - we pray, and we all have a stirring, a longing, to do something. The great news for all of us is that if you're holding this book, you're already part of some pretty big things... like sponsoring hundreds of children in Honduras, bringing clean water to families in Central America, providing refugee support at border crises like Venezuela and Ukraine, and much more. World Vision is meeting the most vulnerable children in their time and place of need with sustainable assistance that is changing the landscape of their challenges. Moving into our 20th year of sponsorships, 5th year of commitments to clean water, and 3rd year investing in disaster relief, we're proud of our partnership with World Vision to bring restoration to communities around our world.



CHILD SPONSORSHIP

With over 200 Artisans sponsoring over 400 children, we're collectively making a huge impact on Honduran families! Sponsorships allow World Vision to invest in and empower communities – focusing on water, healthcare, education, protection, and spiritual growth. WATER PROJECTS

Clean water transforms communities, laying the foundation for major improvements to health, education, and nutrition for families, and opening doors for economic empowerment. RTI and World Vision surpassed the original goal of bringing clean water to 200,000 people and are now tackling remaining communities in rural Honduras. We encourage your family to pray for the communities currently waiting for clean water.

VISION TRIPS


Our dream is to bring every Artisan on a vision trip to Honduras to see the impact World Vision is making on families just like ours. We've made seven 3-day trips to rural areas of Honduras, allowing over 40 Artisans to experience the challenges and beauty of Central America. Typical vision trips look like "Day 1" visiting a community without access to clean water. "Day 2" includes a visit to a community now thriving with clean water, where we often visit a school and learn about additional World Vision efforts to establish sustainability. We get to meet some of our sponsored children and one of their parents or grandparents on "Day 3". These vision trips allow us a front row seat to understand and celebrate the impact our partnership with World Vision is making.



THRIVE

When poverty feels inescapable, it's tough for families to envision a hopeful future. They need real opportunities to grow their incomes. In Honduras, most rural families depend on coffee for their income, but they often lack the knowledge, tools, and mindsets to produce effectively. That's where RTI and World Vision come in. Through intensive agricultural training, better tools, and access to irrigation from the water projects RTI supports, World Vision empowers families to go from barely surviving to thriving. RTI is blessed to support these hard-working coffee farmers by purchasing coffee for our offices directly from coffee producers, providing hope in a cup and joy to our Artisans.





DISASTER RELIEF

Our world is full of crisis situations – some that make the news and many that do not. World Vision already works in these hard places, responding immediately when disaster strikes. Since 2019, RTI has been a significant donor to a wide variety of crises in Venezuela, Yemen, Ukraine, Afghanistan, Honduras, and the US. We're thankful for World Vision's ability to responsibly deploy supplies and food, partnering with local organizations and churches.

Over a dozen Artisans from all parts of our organization jumped in to donate to Ukrainian refugee care when RTI offered a matching opportunity.
